The German grading system is as follows:

1,0 = very good achievement, highest pass of this category

1,3 = very good achievement, second highest pass of this category

1,7 = very good achievement, lowest pass of this category

2,0 = good achievement, highest pass of this category

2,3 = good achievement, second highest pass of this category

2,7 = good achievement, lowest pass of this category

3,0 = achievement is satisfactory, highest pass of this category

3,3 = achievement is satisfactory, second highest pass of this category

3,7 = achievement is satisfactory, lowest pass of this category

4.0 = pass

5,0 = fail

Further abbreviations used in our transcripts:

BE / mEt = pass (no grade awarded)

NB = fail

NE = no-show (for the final exam/assignment)
